

Committees (you may select more than one)

Nominating	Investigate and consider eligible candidates and submit at the annual meeting a slate of candidates for the Board of Directors.
Finance	Investigate ways and means of financing ANSLL including team sponsorships and submit recommendations.
Grounds	Responsible for the care and maintenance of the playing field(s), buildings and grounds. Operate within the amount appropriated in the approved budget for that purpose.
Playing Equipment	Responsible for the proper issuance of such supplies and equipment and for the repair, cleaning and storage thereof at the close of the season.
Managers	Interview and investigate prospective managers and coaches. Committee(s) will recommend acceptable candidates to the President, for approval by the Board of Directors. No appointee shall be on a committee if they are applying for a manager position in that respective division, they may serve on other manager committee(s).
Umpire	Recruit, interview and recommend to the Board for appointment a staff of umpires, including a chief umpire and replacements.
Youth & Coach Development	Develop, propose, execute, and monitor a long-range training plan which will provide the necessary tools to promote standardized training objectives for all minor leagues.
Capital Improvement	Develop, propose, execute, and monitor a long-range capital improvement plan which will assist ANSLL's efforts in becoming a top-notch Little League by planning and properly phasing facilities, equipment, and training upgrades.
Auditing	Review ANSLL's books and records annually prior to the Annual Meeting and attach a statement of their findings to the annual financial statement of the President and Treasurer; or may, if directed by the Board of Directors, secure the services of a Certified Public Accountant to accomplish such review.
