Approval of Minutes:

- **Motion: Sam Hanik moved to approve the January 7, 2026, meeting minutes. Erik Larson seconded. Motion approved by acclamation.**

Treasurer's Report: There is approximately \$124,000 in the bank. The CD has been collapsed. There is \$20,000 less in the bank this year in comparison to this time last year. We are now using the new bank, but we will keep the Truist account open for a while to ensure all payments clear.

Capital improvements for field update: Installation is now on top of the grass at Pine Ridge 1. All work is on track to be completed before the season begins.

Spring 2026 season and registration: There has been a steady stream of registrations. For the Majors, must draft numbers and those who were recommended to move up is up to 60. We anticipate fielding 6 teams of 12 players for the Majors. The AAA pool is 66 kids who played AAA in 2025. There are currently 30 AA kids in 2025 who have been recommended to move to AAA. We anticipate fielding 8 teams of 11 players for AAA. We currently have 75 total kids for AA. We anticipate fielding 8 teams of 10 players for AA. For Intermediate, we have the players and coaches to field a team. There are currently six league age 13 year olds registered, as well as four league age 11 and 12 year old interested in playing.
